### Introduction:

## Year 4 Topics:

<u>History</u>: Romans: A history enquiry-based topic that explored the impact the Romans had on

Concepts: tolerance, failure, equality, identity, freedom, prejudice.

Geography: Earthquakes and Volcanoes

<u>History</u>: Ernest Shackleton's Polar expedition: A topic building on knowledge gained in year 2, looking at climate zones, Shackleton's journey to the Antarctic and the water cycle.

Concepts: Adversity, Difference, Acceptance, Survival & Exploration.

Geography: The Water Cycle

Geography: Comparative study of a region in Greece to the South East in the UK

<u>History</u>: Ancient Greece: Greek myths and exploring 'What were the most important achievements of the Ancient Greeks?'

Concepts: influence, beliefs, achievement, legacy, democracy.

We will also encourage children to consider a 'Growth Mindset' and challenge themselves wherever possible. You will hear lots about 'stretching our brains'!
