Welcome to Year 3 — Rowan and Cedar 2023-2024



Introduction:

Welcome to Year 3. We hope that your children will enjoy their time with us and are motivated by the range of opportunities that we will be providing. Year 3 Topics:

In our first History and Geography units in the autumn term, we will be exploring our local area of Wokingham and how this has developed over the years.

In the spring term, we will learn all about stones and bones! We will have a History enquiry-based topic which explores the life of children in the Stone Age era, where the children will explore the Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic eras. There will be a focus on the science of rocks, fossils and soils. Later in the enquiry, children will learn about the Iron Age. Alongside this there will be scientific discovery and study of animal and human anatomy (bones and muscles).

In the summer term, learning is focused upon the Ancient Egyptians. Our studies will look at their beliefs of the afterlife, different Gods, and this will also link to our Geography topic of rivers, when researching the River Nile.

English and Maths:

Home Learning:

- We encourage all families to focus on the key skills of reading, writing and maths. Please read
 as often as possible with your child and sign his or her Home Reading Record. Please practise
 times tables using the TT Rockstars website, this is very important as times tables will be
 tested in class on a weekly basis too. From time to time, we may post some topic related
 activities on Teams.
- Spelling will be taught in school so focus spellings will not automatically be sent home; however, you are welcome to request a copy of words being learnt if you wish.
- To become quick with recall, practise a minimum of 5 games of Times Tables Rock Stars each week. This could earn them a sticker in Celebration Assembly if they are the top TTRockstar in
